



## Alan "Al" B. Collison

April 16, 1948 - April 28, 2026

PIERCE – Funeral service for Alan B. “Al” Collison, 78, of Pierce will be held at 10:30 a.m., Monday, May 4, 2026 at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. Rev. Bernhard Husemann will be officiating the service. Interment will be held at the Prospect View Cemetery, Pierce. Visitation will be 2:00-6:00 p.m., Sunday, also at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. In lieu of flowers, the family asks that memorials be made to Zion Lutheran Church or School, Faith Health Hospital, or the family for a later designation. Al passed away with his family at his side on Tuesday, April 28, 2026 at the Faith Health Hospital in Norfolk. Stonacek Memorial Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Al was born on April 16, 1948 in Fairbury, Nebraska to Roland and Yuvonne (Casper) Collison. He was baptized on May 9, 1948 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bruning, Nebraska. His family lived in Bruning until moving to Norfolk. Al attended Christ Lutheran School in Norfolk and was confirmed in 1963 at Christ Lutheran Church. He graduated from Norfolk Senior High School in 1966 and then attended Kansas State University for an animal nutrition degree. Al married Jacque Miles on February 14, 1971 at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. After marriage the family moved to Nebraska City and Al managed a feedlot. In 1975, the family moved to Pierce and he established Northeast Nebraska Insulation in Norfolk, and later began the insulation manufacturing company, Parco. Then in 1997 he orchestrated the beginning of MP Global Products an underlayment manufacturing company. He enjoyed

his work, his ranch we know as Al's playground, playing ping pong, card games, and he loved to spend time with his family and attend his grandchildren's events. Al was a dedicated member of Zion Lutheran Church in Pierre.

Survivors include his wife Jacque Collison of Pierre, children Chad Collison (Tammi Taylor) of Pierre, Ryan (Brooke) Collison of Pierre, Beau (Traci) Collison of Pierre, Lynsey (Matt) Herian of Pierre, Nevada (Leah) Claussen of Pierre, 13 grandchildren, 2 great-grandchildren, mother Yuvonne Collison of Norfolk, brother Scott (Jean) Collison of Pierre, SD, sister Monica (Brian) Burck of Fort Collins, CO, brother-in-law Paul Schellpeper of Sioux Falls, SD, and nieces and nephews. Al was preceded in death by his father Roland Collison and sister Kay Schellpeper.
