



## Alfred D. "Junior" Nathan

April 28, 1943 - December 14, 2017

NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Alfred D. "Junior" Nathan, 74, of Norfolk will be held at 11:00 a.m., Monday, December 18, 2017 at the Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk with Rev. Chip Winter officiating. Burial will be held at a later date at New Lutheran Cemetery, Norfolk. Visitation will be held 4:00-7:00 p.m., Sunday, at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Junior died Thursday, December 14, 2017 at the Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Junior Nathan was born to Alfred A. and Helen L. (Gross) Nathan on April 28, 1943, on the family farm near Lindsay. He was baptized on May 30, 1943, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Lindsay and confirmed on March 30, 1958, at Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk. He attended Christ Luthern School in Norfolk.

The family moved to Enola when Alfred was 1 year old and moved to a farm west of Norfolk when he was 4 years old.

He married Elsie Cubbison on Aug. 25, 1963, at Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk.

After their marriage, Alfred and Elsie lived in Norfolk, and Alfred drove for Hinken Trucking in Norfolk. He started driving truck for Vulcraft on May 25, 1964. He hauled the first load of Vulcraft steel. Alfred later worked in the shipping/receiving department for Vulcraft. He retired from Vulcraft on Sept. 16, 2006, after working there for 42 years.

Junior enjoyed many hobbies. He liked garage sales, his fish aquariums,

collecting caps, being a handyman, Menards Rebates and working on his acreage. He also enjoyed doing auto body work and restoring his 1977 Chevy Pickup. He also built two horse trailers.

Survivors include his wife, Elsie Nathan of Norfolk; sons Brad (Deann) Nathan of Omaha and Darren Nathan of Hoskins; grandchildren, Kyle Greenwood and Jonah Nathan; siblings Wilbur Nathan of Madison, Alvin Nathan of Battle Creek, Duane (Joyanne) Nathan of Norfolk and Darlene (Jim) Barritt of Norfolk; sister-in-law Judy Cubbison of Norfolk; and numerous nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Alfred and Helen Nathan; brother-in-law Wes Cubbison; and sisters-in-law, Aletha Nathan and Vicki Nathan.
