NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Alice E. Nelson, 77, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Thursday, January 25, 2024 at the Mount Olive Lutheran Church in Norfolk. Rev. Alice passed away on Friday, January 19, 2024 at the Faith Regional Hospital in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Alice was born on July 23, 1946 in Norfolk to Elmer and Esther (Krueger) Chapman. Alice lived in rural Stanton until 1956. Alice attended District 12 (Bega) School. The family moved south of Norfolk for one year, later moving west of Pierce. Alice graduated from Pierce High School in 1965.

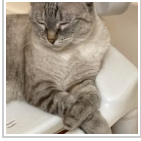
