



## Alta E. Wieting Peters

January 6, 1915 - January 25, 2013

FOSTER -- Services for Alta E. Wieting Peters, 98, of Pierce will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Trinity Lutheran Church in Foster with burial in Zion Lutheran Cemetery and the Rev. Jerome Leckband officiating. Visitation will be 4-8 p.m. Wednesday at Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce. She died Friday, Jan. 25, 2013, at Pierce Manor. She was born Jan. 6, 1915, at Pierce to Fred and Anna (Kort) Zierke. She was baptized by Pastor Martin Scheips at Zion Lutheran Church, Pierce, and confirmed by Pastor Enno Budde at Stark Valley Church, rural Plainview. Alta attended school at District 9 through the 10th grade and then graduated from Pierce High School with the class of 1933. She married Fred Wieting in 1935 and married Elmer Peters May 1987 at Trinity Lutheran Church, Foster. In 1935, Alta married Fred Wieting, and they worked for U.S. Chilquist for five years, and in 1940 they moved to their present farm where Alta lived until 2009 when she went to reside at the Pierce Manor. To this union were born two children, a daughter, Mary Wieting Sporleder, and a son, Kenneth Wieting.

She was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church, Foster. Survivors include her daughter, Mary Sporleder, and son Kenneth and wife Diana Wieting, all of Pierce, and grandchildren, great-grandchildren, stepgreat-grandchildren and great-great-grandchildren.
