Bud worked at Alfalfa Dehydration Plant. The family moved to Beatrice. Bud worked for Missile Site 5 for two years. The family moved back to Norfolk. Bud worked for Theisen Construction driving a scraper. The family moved to Fremont where Bud was a welder for Stormor for eight years. Bud moved back to Pierce in 1976 and worked at Amoco, Conoco and Tom's Service and retired in 2007. The couple was divorced.

Bud enjoyed his time with family and grandchildren, gardening and taking care

of his yard and pets, gambling, playing scratch cards and word search puzzles.

He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church, Pierce, and the Pierce American Legion and V.F.W., Norfolk.

Survivors include one son, Rod and wife Julie Jonson of Pierce, daughter Cathy Logan of Norfolk; seven grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; one great-great grandchild, Jamie (Paul) Marymee, Alexis, Michael, Bridgette, Stephen Brandy (Derek) Price, Izzabelle, Easton, Sophia; Brooke (David) Drees, Cambrie, Beckett, R.J.
