After graduation, she moved to Norfolk and worked as an insurance agent at Town and Country Insurance. Later, she relocated to Colorado for five years and worked for Enterprise. Her time in Colorado fueled her love for outdoor adventures and travel. She moved back to Norfolk in July of 2023.

Jesus was Amy's Lord and Savior, and His love for her compelled her to serve on two international mission trips, support multiple children through

Compassion International, and volunteer at various organizations.

Amy is survived by her mother, Jane Rademacher, of Norfolk; siblings Sarah (Rod) Schwartz of Pierce, and Jay (Kyla) Rademacher of Norwalk, IA; and nephews and nieces Bradyn, Brecken, Brynn, Lauryn, Gabe, and Josiah. She was preceded in death by her father, Jerol Rademacher.
