Anne was born on September 7, 1941 rural Plainview to Ed and Rose (Baumann) Lerum. She Attended grade school at Plainview Public Schools and graduated from Plainview High School in 1959. She was baptized at the Congregational Church in Plainview and was confirmed at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Foster. Anne married Jack Weber on March 3, 1961 at the Congregational Church in Plainview. The couple moved to Pierce in 1967 and became faithful members at Zion Lutheran Church in 1970. friends, and always attended the grandchildren's activities.
