NORFOLK – Funeral service for Anthony “Tony” Lemm, 56, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, January 24, 2024 at Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk with Reverend Cal Kapels officiating. Interment will take place at Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery in Norfolk. A visitation will be held from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 23, 2024 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Tony passed away on Thursday, January 18, 2024 at the Providence Medical Center in Wayne. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Tony was born on September 29, 1967 in Norfolk Nebraska to Dale and Catherine (Filas) Lemm. He was baptized on November 19, 1967 at the Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk and later confirmed on April 25, 1982 also at Christ Lutheran Church.
