Audrey passed away on Thursday, May 25, 2023 at the Faith Regional Hospital in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Audrey was born on March 20, 1932 on the farm northwest of Stanton to Rolland and Libbie (Kment) Clark. She attended District #6 through the 8th grade. She accepted the Lord as her Savior as a young girl. At the age of 54 she obtained her G.E.D. which had been a lifelong dream. On March 20, 1949 she married Everett Ehrenberg in Creighton and spent the next 40 years as a farm wife. In 1987 the couple moved to Norfolk. Everett passed away in 1989. On March 29, 1992 she married Reinhold Weigel in Norfolk. She enjoyed crocheting and embroidery, and home decoration. She was especially fond of her little dogs.
