Barbara Lea Jasper was born on July 24, 1955 in Herrick, SD to Norven and Shirley Mayer. Barb was the oldest of eight children (five sisters and three brothers). Barb graduated from Butte Public High School in Butte, NE in 1973 and married Raymond Frasch on June 16, 1973, at St. Paul’s Lutheran Church in Naper, NE.

Barb and Ray owned a small dairy farm near Burke, SD where they started a family with three children, Leah, Brandon, and Larissa. During this time Barb started a dog breeding business and found a passion for painting, sewing, and baking. Barb attended local art and craft fairs selling her paintings and hand-sewn doll clothes. Barb and Ray were members of Peace Lutheran Church in Carlock, SD where Barb taught Sunday school classes for children.

In 1986, Barb and Ray moved to Johnstown, CO. Barb worked at Coors Brewing Company in Johnstown, CO and worked as a construction zone flagger for the Colorado DOT. The family enjoyed taking trips to the Rocky Mountains. Barb and Ray moved to Elgin, NE in 1988 where they had their fourth child Leesha. The couple stayed busy with the children's activities. Barb worked at Blackburn Manufacturing in Neligh, NE from 1990-1993. Barb joined the US Postal Service in 1993 as a mail processing clerk in Norfolk, NE. Barb and Ray were members of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Norfolk, NE.

After 21 years of marriage, Barb and Ray went separate ways. Barb moved to Norfolk, NE in 1994. Barb and Ray continued a good relationship for their children and grandchildren. Barb married Shyuan "Shy" Jasper on July 25, 1997, and gained a stepdaughter Shyquilla. Both Barb and Shy worked at the US Post Office in Norfolk, NE. They juggled their demanding work schedules while raising Leesha and Shyquilla. In their free time, they enjoyed having the grandchildren over to play in the pool and watch movies. Barb and Shy enjoyed traveling and riding motorcycles. Barb enjoyed riding her Harley Davidson trike. Barb and Shy were married for 11 years.

Barb retired from the US Post Office in 2007 after 14 years of service. After retirement, Barb enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren, painting, reading, crocheting, and shopping with her friend Deb Atkinson. Barb had a special gift of helping others as a mentor and sponsor for Alcoholics Anonymous (A.A) for over 20 years. Barb was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Norfolk, NE and had strong faith in her Savior Jesus Christ.

The Lord called Barb to her heavenly home on April 8, 2026. Barb gave one final selfless gift to others by being an organ and tissue donor. To honor Barb

for the lives she will save, she received an "Honor Walk" at Nebraska Medicine (UNMC). We take comfort in knowing Barb will forever be an angel among us.
