After their marriage, Betty and Don farmed in the Meadow Grove area for 10 years. They then moved to town and were in the grocery business for two years. The family moved to Norfolk in 1965. Betty worked at Dale Electronics from 1980 until retiring in 1993. After retirement, Betty worked at the Northeast Community College Bookstore.

Betty and Don were avid Nebraska Cornhusker football fans; they also followed and attended the Cornhusker basketball, volleyball, track and gymnastics events. He passed away on June 7, 2013.

Betty loved her family and enjoyed going to her grandkids' activities. She also enjoyed her flowers, embroidery work and puzzles. She was a member of the Westridge United Methodist Church and American Legion Auxiliary.
