Betty Jane was born March 12, 1933, at the family home near Battle Creek, to Clyde and Bertha (Lampert) Osborne. She was the youngest of 10 children, losing her mother at age 16. She graduated from Battle Creek High School in 1950. Betty married Don Walmsley on Jan. 14, 1951, at Heights Church in Battle Creek. What began with a car ride with friends, grew into a God centered love story that would serve as an example for generations.

They settled on a farm northwest of Norfolk, raising cattle, crops, and children – five daughters: Pat (Duane) Wilken, Pam (Tim) Volk, Jayne (Larry) Eclov, Judy (Neal) Brower, and Cathy (Greg) Berggren. Much of Betty's adult life was spent showing God's love to others. She was the heart of her family – a devoted wife, a loving mother and playful grandmother.

Betty was a fantastic host and cook, known for her soft raisin cookies and homemade noodles. When her home was full, her heart was also. She worked with kids in her home, at church and through 4-H.

Betty is survived by her husband of 75 years, her five daughters, 18 grandchildren, 50 great-grandchildren, and 13 great-great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, siblings, a son-in-law, and 2 grandchildren.

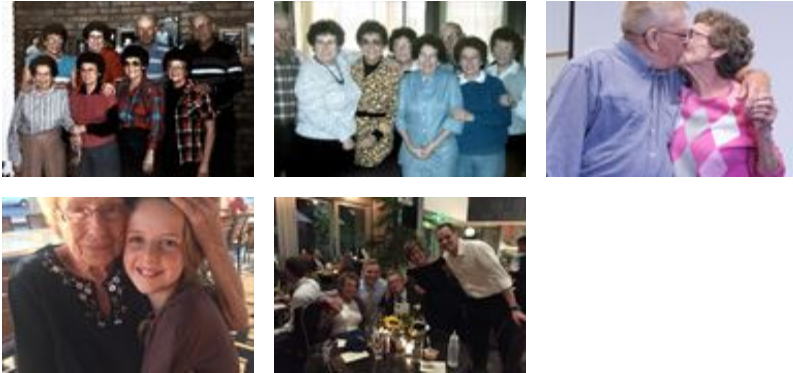
