She attended School District 66 in Antelope County to the eighth grade and graduated from Plainview High School in 1956. She then taught in rural schools. In 1964, they moved northeast of Osmond. They retired from farming in February of 2004. She moved to Osmond in 2010. Betty enjoyed quilting, crocheting, embroidery, painting, reading and writing. She was a member of the United Methodist Church in Osmond, was a Sunday school teacher, past choir member, historian for the church and a past sanctuary building committee member. She was a member of a Bible study group and active in the 4-H program for 40 years. Survivors are her children, David and wife Coni Wiegert of Sioux Falls, S.D., Denisha and husband Ryan (Rocky) Kickland of Chamberlain, S.D., John and wife Daphne Wiegert of Wausa, Ruth and husband David Smith of Sunny Brook, Del.; 13 grandchildren and 17 great-grandchildren; a sister, Alyce and

husband Larry Wiegert of Osmond; brothers-in-law Gene Toelle of Beemer and Doug Weber of Campbell, Texas. She was preceded in death by her parents, Adolph and Lucile; a daughter, Kathryn; a son, Daniel; her husband, Dwain; sisters Sylvia Toelle and Barbara Weber; and one brother, William.
