Beverly was born in Norfolk to her loving parents Elmer and Mollie (Busch) Wagner on July 19, 1946. She was raised along with her two siblings Ronnie and Mary, on the family farm northeast of Pierce. Beverly was an active member of her church Pierce United Church of Christ, playing the piano and organ. Beverly was a member of the Ladies Aid, church board, Sunday school teacher. In addition, she was a lifelong member of P.E.O and Eastern Star.
