



## Bob L. Carlson

April 4, 1940 - June 7, 2017

NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Bob Carlson, 77, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 am, Monday, June 12, 2017 at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with Rev. Terry Buol officiating. Born April 4, 1940, in Burke, S.D., Bobby Lee Carlson was the sixth of Emma Welfl Carlson and Lloyd Carlson's nine children. He graduated from Burke High School in 1958 and joined the U.S. Army in 1961.

Bob and Mary Gibson were united in marriage on Oct. 23, 1962, in Springview. Four children were born into this union — Maribel, Kathleen, Jim and Corina.

On Feb. 10, 1980, he and Lana Grigsby were joined in marriage in Omaha. His family gained two stepdaughters, Tanya and Terrie.

Bob served our country in the U.S. Army for four years. He was a farmer and a rancher, then a driver for Affiliated Foods. He retired in 2002 after delivering groceries for 20 years. Bob never met a stranger and made many friends along the way. Bob cherished his family and enjoyed baseball (avid L.A. Dodgers fan), camping, hunting, fishing and reading.
