Bonnie J. Tucker, 83, of Norfolk died Wednesday, March 12, 2014, at Faith Regional Health Services, Norfolk. Memorial services will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel with visitation 4-7 p.m. Friday and the Rev. Ray Wilke officiating. Private family inurnment will be at a later date. She was born July 17, 1930, at rural Meadow Grove to William and Eula (Halsey) Schlueter. She attended District 6 School in Stanton County, Stanton High School and graduated from Norfolk High School in 1947. She was married to Ervin Tucker March 9, 1949, at the Presbyterian Church, Norfolk. After Ervin's time in the service, Bonnie and Ervin returned to Norfolk. Bonnie was secretary at Schlueter Implement and Oliver Dealership until 1960. They then began a custom corn shelling and hay moving business that changed a few years later to custom hay grinding and combing business. They moved north of Battle Creek in 1977 and added a livestock and farming operation. Bonnie was also employed at Lynn and Sons Grocery, working in the bakery, Baber's Greenhouse and Shopko. They grew and sold watermelons in the area for nearly 70 years. She was a past member of the Battle Creek Methodist Church. Survivors include children Marsha and husband Terry Rotherham of Norfolk, Ward and wife Theresa Tucker of Meadow Grove; nine grandchildren, Jess (Kayla) Rotherham of Bertram, Texas, Zack (Sarah) Tucker of Omaha, Kelly (Jason) Diaz of Brooklyn, Wis., Adam (Chelsea) Tucker of Meadow Grove, Jacob (Rachelle) Tucker of San Antonio, Texas, Aaron (Mary) Tucker of Lincoln, Alyssa (Mike) Martin of San Antonio, Ashley Tucker of Meadow
