



Bradley J. Lange

PIERCE — Services for Bradley J. Lange, 56, of Pierce will be at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at St. Boniface Catholic Church in Menominee, Neb. Burial will be at St. Boniface Catholic Cemetery, Menominee. The Revs. Marc Lim and Mike Stratman will officiate. Visitation will be 4-7 p.m. Monday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk, with the Rosary at 7 p.m. Bradley died from complications of cancer on Thursday, Feb. 18, 2016, at Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk.

Bradley J. Lange 56, of Pierce, was born January 26, 1960, to Antonette (Steffen) and Quintin Lange in Yankton, S.D. While living at Hartington, he attended grade school at Holy Trinity and high school at Cedar Catholic, graduating in 1978. He then attended Northeast Community College and graduated with a degree in building construction. He worked at the Norfolk Regional Center as a psychiatric technician from 1982 to 1989. He also started at Dinkel Implement, working part time, in 1979, and began working full time there in 1989. He retired from Dinkels in October of 2014, when he became ill and was diagnosed with cancer. Brad married Kelly Erb in 1981 and they were blessed with a son, Adam. In 1989, he married Kandice Bolz and gained a stepson, Jason. Most important to him was his faith and spending time with his family and friends. Brad had a heart of gold and was always willing to help others. Brad passed away Thursday, February 18, at Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk from complications of his illness. He is survived by his spouse Kandi, sons Adam of Vermillion, S.D, and Jason and

his wife Amy of Osmond, and grandchildren Gill, Breanna, Emily, Carson, and Kayleigh. He is also survived by his sisters Cindy Stratman and husband Mike of Terra Haute, Ind., Tammie Eskens and her husband Ron of Fordyce and Beth Kunzie and husband Ken of Norfolk. He was preceded in death by his parents and grandparents.

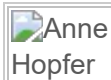

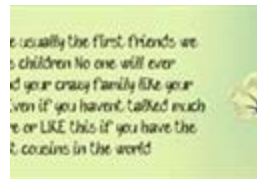

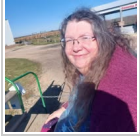
