NORFOLK -- Memorial service for Brandon R. Johnson, 42, of Spearfish, SD, formerly of Norfolk, will be held at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, October 2, 2024 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Rev. Terry Buol will be officiating the service. Private family burial will be at a later date. Brandon passed away on Tuesday, September 24, 2024 in Spearfish, SD. Military rites will be conducted by the American Legion Post #16, V.F.W. Post #1644, and the United States Air Force Honor Guard. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Brandon was born on September 9, 1982 in Norfolk, Nebraska to Ray and Pam (Phillips) Johnson. He attended grade school in Norfolk and graduated from Norfolk Senior High School in 2000. Brandon served in the United States Army as a medic and then in the United States Air Force as a mechanic. He was stationed in Japan. He married Stevie Colwell on August 8, 2007 in Stanton, Nebraska. After marriage, he traveled for his job in Florida, Texas, Minnesota, and California. The last 7 years he has been working as a traveling welder specializing with stainless steel welding and owned his own business, Ridgeline Fabrication in Spearfish, SD. Brandon appreciated working with metal and drawing.

Brandon is survived by his wife Stevie Johnson of Spearfish, SD, 4 children Mason, Maddi, Rylie, and Logan, father and step-mother Ray (Mary) Johnson

of Crofton, mother-in-law Lori Nore of Rapid City, SD, sisters Brandi Johnson of Ashland, Laura Johnson of Greeley, CO, Abby Johnson of Yankton, SD. He was preceded in death by his mother Pam, grandparents Harold and Phyllis Bussey, and grandfather Marvin Taege.
