NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Brenda L. Boldt, 68, of Norfolk, formerly of Stanton will be held at 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with Pastor Ryan Taylor officiating. Interment will be held in the Stanton City Cemetery, Stanton. Visitation will be 4:00-7:00 p.m., Monday, also at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Brenda died Wednesday, July 11, 2018 at Edgewood Vista in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Born Sept. 7, 1949, at Jerome, Idaho, she was the daughter of Earl and Vionne (Berg) Forsch. She graduated from Norfolk High School in 1967 and then went to Wayne State College, where she obtained a degree in education. She married Marlen Boldt on Dec. 4, 1971, at Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk. After marriage, Brenda and Marlen lived on the Boldt family farm in Stanton. In 1971, she started teaching in country schools in both Stanton and Madison counties, teaching children in kindergarten through eighth grade. Brenda was very kind, had a wonderful sense of humor and a huge heart. She had a love for writing poetry and making art and was even a published poet. Brenda enjoyed helping children, visiting with people and going to the Wolf's Den. But most of all, she loved being a grandma. Brenda was at Edgewood Vista since November 2017.

She was a member of Faith Lutheran Church in Stanton.

Survivors are her daughter, Jennifer Boldt of Urbandale, Iowa; a son, Brandon Boldt of Norfolk and his girlfriend, Lea Bittner of Norfolk; a granddaughter,

Mathisen Boldt of Tilden; a sister, Cynthia Ave and spouse Ron Bunch of Tacoma, Wash.; many nieces and nephews; and two brothers-in-law, LaVaughn Boldt of Norfolk and Robert (Karen) Boldt of Norfolk.

She was preceded in death by her spouse, Marlen, who died Dec. 12, 2009; her parents; an infant niece, Shellee; and her in-laws, Delwyn and Patricia Boldt and Arlyce Boldt.
