NORFOLK — Services for Bryan D. “Zip” Tomasek, 59, of Norfolk will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Pastor Marshal Hardy will officiate. Private burial will be at a later date. Visitation will be 4-7 p.m. Sunday at the funeral chapel. He died Thursday, Oct. 13, 2016, at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha. 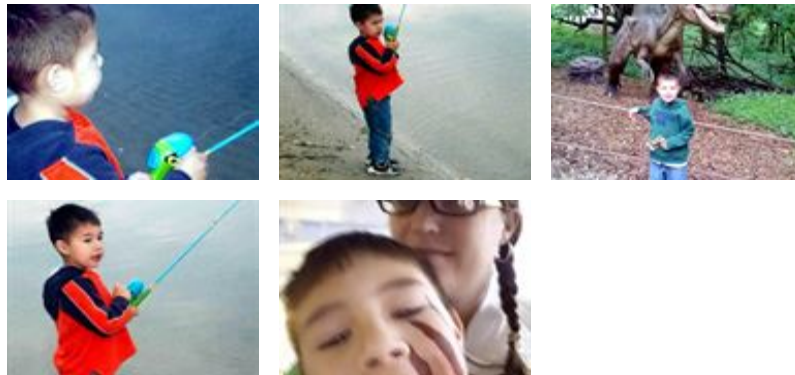

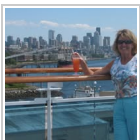
