NORFOLK -- Carlyle Vietor, 91, of Norfolk died Wednesday, Oct. 24, 2012, at the Norfolk Veterans Home. Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with visitation 4-7 p.m. Tuesday. The Rev. Terry Buol will officiate with burial in Orchard Hill Cemetery in Orchard. Military rites will be by American Legion Post 136. He was born at Riverton Township, Floyd County, Iowa, to Fred A. and Rose May (Gifford) Vietor. He served in the Army in World War II from Oct. 21, 1942, to Nov. 10, 1945, and was awarded three Bronze Stars. He was married to Laura Bernetta Miller Aug. 18, 1946, at the Congregational Church, Neligh. They farmed in Iowa until 1948 and then moved to Nebraska where he worked in the grocery business. In 1970, he went full time at the Norfolk Livestock Market, retiring there in 1991. Carl and Laura enjoyed bus tours in their retirement together. His church affiliation was First United Methodist Church, Norfolk. Survivors include children Linda and husband Doug Breitreutz of Wisner, Donald Vietor of Norfolk, Pam Vietor of Norfolk; eight grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren, two great-great-grandchildren; two sisters, Maxine Vetter of Charles City, Iowa, and Evelyn Drenth of Racine, Minn.
