NORFOLK — Services for Charles Thayer, 85, Norfolk, will be at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. The Rev. Terry Buol will officiate with burial in Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery. Military rites will be conducted by American Legion Tomek-Otto Post 72 and U.S. Army Honors Guard. Visitation will be 4-7 p.m. Tuesday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. He died Saturday, Nov. 26, 2016, at Norfolk Veterans Home.

The son of Edward and Rose (Nansel) Thayer was born May 27, 1931, in Monroe. He grew up in Platte County, where he attended rural school through eighth grade. In 1947, the Thayer family moved to Pierce on a farm. He served in the U.S. Army from 1951 to 1955.

On Dec. 5, 1962, at Columbus, he married Lillie Schneider. The couple farmed north of Pierce. They moved to Pierce in 1966. Charlie worked as a janitor at Norfolk Public Schools for 26 years. He also had a mowing and snow removal business in Pierce. Charlie has been at the Norfolk Veterans Home since November of 2013. He was a member of the Pierce American Legion. Survivors are sisters Norma Thayer of Hooper, Phyllis Makuch of Warren, Mich., and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, Edward and Rose; his spouse, Lillie; three brothers, Larry Thayer, Clifford Thayer and Leland Thayer; four sisters, Marilee DuBeau, Ruth Carson, Evelyn Thayer and Carolyn Greenberger. Music will be a recorded version of "Amazing Grace." Casket Bearers will be Dan Thayer, Steve Thayer, Shane Thayer, Greg Thelen, Jon Lance and Tim Menke.
