



## Charles D. "Chuck" Volquardsen

April 24, 1957 - July 4, 2017

BATTLE CREEK -- Funeral service for Charles D. "Chuck" Volquardsen, 60, of Norfolk, formerly of Battle Creek will be held at 11:00 a.m., Monday, July 10, 2017 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with Pastor B.J. Fouts officiating. Chuck passed away Tuesday, July 4, 2017 at his residence in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Born April 24, 1957, in Norfolk, he was the son of Bernard and Iola (Merritt) Volquardsen. He was baptized Dec. 8, 1957, at Mount Olive Lutheran Church in Norfolk and confirmed April 4, 1971, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Battle Creek. He attended St. John's Lutheran School in Battle Creek and graduated from Battle Creek High School in 1975.

After graduating from high school, Chuck served in the U.S. Army from July 11, 1975, to July 10, 1979, as a tank commander in Germany. After his service, Chuck moved to Battle Creek and worked construction for Nucor Steel. He was later hired by Nucor Steel and worked in the melt shop. He worked there for 36 years until retiring in 2012. Chuck served as a supervisor his last 10 years while at Nucor.

He married Garnet Lovro on May 2, 1981, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Battle Creek. They were later divorced.

Charles was an avid Nebraska Cornhuskers fan. He enjoyed golfing, fishing, hunting, riding his Harley-Davidson, and especially spending time with his family.

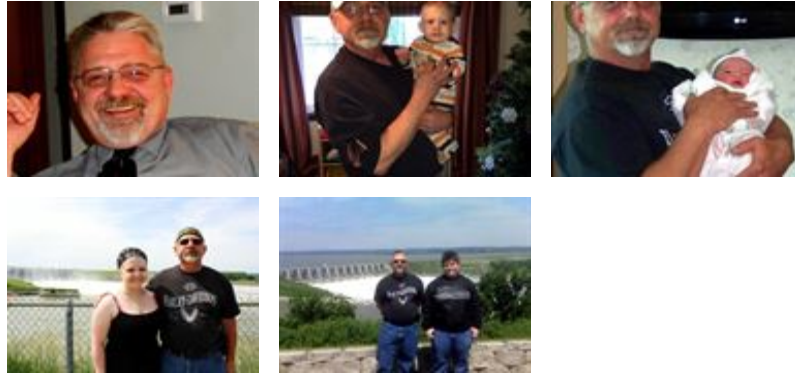
