BATTLE CREEK — Memorial services for Charlie Kohles, 25, of Battle Creek will be at 11 a.m. Saturday at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Deacon Jim Doolittle will officiate. Private inurnment will be at a later date. Visitation will begin at 9 a.m. and continue until service time Saturday at the funeral chapel. He died Monday, Aug. 22, 2016, in Des Moines, Iowa.

The son of Ed O'Connor and Kristy (Kohles) Goetsch was born July 16, 1991, in Norfolk. He attended grade school in Norfolk and later attended grade school and high school in Battle Creek. In 2013, Charlie purchased his own dump truck and operated his own business throughout Northeast Nebraska and Iowa.
