NORFOLK — Memorial services for Chris W. Wulf, 82, of Norfolk will be at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Military rites will be by American Legion Post 16, VFW Post 1644 and the Air Force Honors Guard. The Rev. Steve Lund will officiate with private family inurnment. He died Saturday, Nov. 22, 2014, at home. He was born June 3, 1932, at Bloomfield to Walter H. and Lola Mae (Sigler) Wulf and was baptized and confirmed at Bloomfield. He attended country school through the seventh grade and graduated from Bloomfield High School in 1950. He was married to Arlin Mae Carr on Dec. 10, 1952, in Bloomfield at St. Mark's Lutheran Church. After serving in the Air Force from March 24, 1951, to March 23, 1955, he farmed for two years and then returned to the field of mechanics. He went from being an aircraft mechanic to auto mechanic, working in Norfolk for many years. He had his own business, Wulf's Repair in Hadar. Following a heart attack in 1980, he finished with continuing his working years as a mechanic supervisor for the Nebraska Department of Roads until his retirement in 1994. He enjoyed fishing and gardening as long as he could get around. Chris enjoyed traveling to Arizona and Oregon, and camping and boating during the summer, especially at Millers Creek. He was a member of Christ Lutheran Church, Norfolk, and attended Christ the Servant Church occasionally. Survivors are wife Arlin M. Wulf of Norfolk; children Judith Lee and husband Scott Trantina, Eugene, Ore., Michael Chris and wife Becki Wulf, Norfolk, Brian Douglas and wife Dana Wulf, Prescott, Ariz., Beverly Ruth Wulf,

Eugene; five grandchildren and six great-grandchildren; sisters and brothers-in-law Ruth Ann and Ferdy Mefford, Missouri Valley, Iowa, and Linnea and Robert Stein, Yankton, S.D.
