Christine died Wednesday, April 3, 2019 at her mothers home in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Christine A. Boone, daughter of Dennis and Jan (Sohl) Longe was born Jan. 12, 1966, in Norfolk. She was baptized at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Plainview and confirmed at First United Methodist Church in Norfolk. She attended grade school in Norfolk, graduated from Norfolk Public High School, and then received a medical assistant degree in California.

After high school, Christine moved to San Diego, Calif., with her first spouse, who was serving in the military. They later moved to Camarillo, Calif., and then Loveland, Colo., before returning to Norfolk.

She married Jason Boone on Feb. 14, 1995, in Madison. The couple lived in Plainview, where they raised their son, Aaron, for 14 years. They later moved to Madison in 2016.

Christine's favorite things to do were cheering on Aaron in track, wrestling and

martial arts. She enjoyed riding her motorcycle with Jason, Tony and Kerri, driving her Ford Mustang "Hot Red," flowers, gardening and compiling a legendary Pinterest account.

She was a member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Plainview
