



## Clara L. Gutz

March 20, 1915 - April 24, 2017

OSMOND — Funeral service for Clara L. Gutz, 102, Osmond, will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday, April 27, 2017 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond. Burial will be at Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery in Norfolk. Visitation will be 4-7:00 p.m. Wednesday also at the Immanuel Lutheran Church. She died Monday, April 24, 2017, at the Osmond Care Center.

On Monday, April 24, 2017, Clara Lois Gutz entered into eternal rest at the age of 102 at the Osmond Care Center. She was born March 20, 1915, to Hugo and Wilhelmine (Luellman) Gnewuch near rural Bloomfield, Mont.

She was baptized Nov. 8, 1915, by the Rev. Martin Rockwell. When she was four years old, she moved with her parents to a farm near St. John, N.D. In 1923, she moved with her parents to Bloomfield.

She attended First Trinity Lutheran School for three years and Bloomfield High School through the 11th grade. She was confirmed April 13, 1930, at First Trinity Lutheran Church.

On June 9, 1935, she married Martin A. Gutz at First Trinity Lutheran Church in Bloomfield. For 36 years, they resided on a farm southwest of Osmond. In 1971, she moved with her spouse to a new home in Osmond.

She was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church and its Lutheran Women's Missionary League. She enjoyed quilting, reading and writing. She was a stay-at-home spouse and mother. Martin passed away on April 24, 1995.

She is survived by her children: Byron (Carleen) Gutz of Osmond, Grace (
