FOSTER — Services for Clarence E.P. Weber, 92, of Pierce will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday at Trinity Lutheran Church at Foster with burial in Prospect View Cemetery at Pierce and the Rev. Survivors are sons Donald and wife Carrie Weber of Seward, Gary and wife Nancy Weber of Norfolk, Mark and wife Missy Weber of Stephenville, Texas; daughters Katheryn and husband Randy Russell of Spotsylvania, Va., Marion and husband Chris Hughes of Roswell, Ga.; daughter-in-law Marjorie Weber of Pierce; sister Jeanine Zimmerman of Norfolk; 14 grandchildren and 25 great-grandchildren.
