NORFOLK -- Clifford H. Lee, 87, of Norfolk died Saturday, Oct. 27, 2012, at the Golden Living Center. Memorial services will be at a later date.

Arrangements are by Stonacek Funeral Chapel. He was born Jan. 16, 1925, at Omaha to Christian and Helen (Karstad) Lee. He was raised in the Albion area and graduated from Newman Grove High School in 1942. He was drafted into the Army in 1945 and was stationed in Fort Hood, Texas, and served in World War II in Germany until 1947. He married Glenda Chatham Feb. 23, 1947, at South Branch parsonage. Upon returning from World War II he started his craftsmanship as a carpenter in Norfolk from 1948 to 1973. He worked for Hespe Construction. They then moved to Helena, Mont. From 1973 to 1987, Cliff worked for the Helena Public School District. He retired after 44 years in February 1987. They later on moved back to Norfolk.

Survivors include wife Glenda (Chatham) Lee of Norfolk, married 65 years; four grandchildren, Tony Lee, Tanya (Lee) Jones and spouse, Trenton Lee and spouse and Tina Lee; 11 great-grandchildren; brothers-in-law, sisters-in-laws, many nieces, nephew and cousins.
