



## Clinton R. "Clint" Hogendorn

August 14, 1970 - October 14, 2017

NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Clinton R. "Clint" Hogendorn, 47, formerly of Pierce, will be held at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, October 18, 2017 at the Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk with Rev. David Goehmann officiating. Interment will be at the Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery, Norfolk. Visitation will be 4:00-7:00 p.m., Tuesday at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Clinton passed away Saturday, October 14, 2017 in Higginsville, Missouri after a two year struggle with a heart condition, Clint is now at peace. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Clinton Robert "Clint" Hogendorn was born on Aug. 14, 1970, in Norfolk, to Donald and Karen (Buss) Hogendorn. He was baptized on Sept. 6, 1970, at Zion Lutheran Church in Leigh. He attended Zion Lutheran School in Pierce and was confirmed at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce on April 29, 1984. He attended Pierce High School, graduating in 1988.

Clint was involved in 4-H, FFA, football and state weightlifting competitions. In high school, he set a state record in the bench press. Following high school, Clint farmed in the Pierce area and took truck driver training at Northeast Community College in Norfolk. He drove truck for various companies over the years. He later moved to North Dakota, where he farmed, raised cattle and drove truck. At the time of his death, he was living in Blackwell, Okla., where he helped at harvest and drove truck. Clint enjoyed farming, especially seeing the crop come in at harvest. After a two-year struggle with a heart condition, he is now at peace.

Survivors are his parents, Donald and Karen Hogendorn of Norfolk; a brother, Chad Hogendorn and his fiancée, Stacey McCroden, and children Ashley and Zachary of Pierce; a sister, Kara (Bradley) Dusatko and their children, Alyssa, Grant and Lauryn of Hastings; and numerous aunts, uncles and cousins. He was preceded in death by his paternal and maternal grandparents.
