



Cloyde W. Stoltzman

November 24, 1921 - October 1, 2015

NORFOLK — Private services for Cloyde W. Stoltzman, 93, Norfolk, will be at a later date under the direction of Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. The Rev. Ray Wilke will officiate. Visitation will be 5-7 p.m. Monday at the funeral chapel.

He died Thursday, Oct. 1, 2015, at Golden Living Center in Norfolk.

The son of Fred and Ethel (Filkens) Stoltzman was born Nov. 24, 1921, at Brunswick. He graduated from Brunswick High School.

He married Lavila D. Lichtenberg on Aug. 1, 1944, at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. Cloyde and Lavila met at the Kings Ballroom in Norfolk. They were later married, and Cloyde served in the U.S. Army from Feb. 5, 1944, to April 24, 1946.

After his service, Cloyde and Lavila moved to West Point and then later Neligh, where he worked as manager for Central Finance for both places. Cloyde and Lavila later moved to Norfolk, and he worked for Henningsen's Foods for numerous years until his retirement in 1983 from health reasons. Throughout his retirement, Cloyde enjoyed camping, gardening and watching the Chicago Cubs baseball team.

He was a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Norfolk.

Survivors include his spouse, Lavila Stoltzman of Norfolk; son Kevin and spouse Tracy Stoltzman of Norfolk; daughter Debbie and spouse Jim Mozer of Monroe; and grandchildren Matthew Mozer of Monroe and Michael Mozer of Columbus.

He was preceded in death by his parents. Fred and Ethel, and a sister, Leona Mauer.
