NORFOLK — Cole E. Haglund, 94, of Wakefield died Sunday, March 15, 2015, at Careage Campus of Care in Wayne. Private family memorial services will be at a later date under direction of Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. He was born Oct. 1, 1920, at rural Wakefield to Elmer and Katherine (Engleit) Haglund and attended Wakefield Public Schools. He entered the United States Air Force on Sept. 21, 1942. He served in the South Pacific and was honorably discharged Jan. 10, 1946. Cole farmed with his brothers, Stanley and Allen, in the Wakefield area.

He married Loretta Mosely on Dec. 1, 1950, at Wayne, and they raised two sons, Stanley and Demont. They retired from farming in 1975.

Cole worked at Milton Walbaum Company for 20 years in various positions. His favorite pastimes were airplanes, and boating and restoring antiques. His greatest joy was spending time with family.

Survivors include his two sons, Stanley and wife Connie Haglund of Norfolk, and Demont and wife Pam Haglund of Wayne; four grandchildren, Angela Haglund of Vermillion, S.D., Alicia Haglund of Vermillion, Jennifer Haglund of Wayne and Kevin Haglund of Wayne.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Elmer and Katherine; wife Loretta; two brothers, Stanley Haglund and Allen Haglund.
