Connie was born on December 4th, 1939 on the farm in rural Lawrence, NE to Mark and Leona (Reining) Himmelberg. Connie attended Sacred Heart Grade School in Lawrence, NE and graduated from Lawrence High School.

After they were married, they lived in Lincoln, Davenport, and in Hastings for 22 years where she worked as a realtor and was a member of the choir at her church. 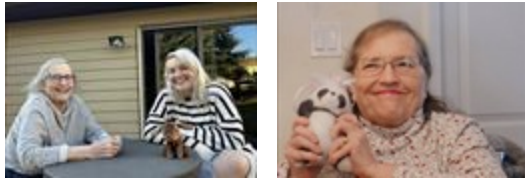
