Darlene Woslager was born Sept. 23, 1935, in Neligh to parents John and Elisa (Uecker) Bellar. She attended Tilden Public schools and graduated from Tilden High School in 1953. Darlene grew up in Tilden and moved to Norfolk and worked as a waitress at the Old Hotel in Madison.
