PIERCE — Memorial services for Darold J. Halsey, 80, Pierce, will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday at Christ Lutheran Church in Pierce. The Rev. Becky Beckmann will officiate. The son of Bruce and Elvira “Peggy” (Freeman) Halsey was born June 29, 1936, at Tilden. He was baptized and confirmed at Christ Lutheran Church in Pierce. He attended Tilden country school before graduating from Pierce High School in 1954.

On Sept. 12, 1955, at Sioux City, he married Donna Meyer. The couple lived in Norfolk and managed S & S Farm Supply. He later managed stores in O’Neill and Valentine. They moved to Pierce and farmed for six years. He also worked at the Pierce Creamery and A.S.C.S. office out of South Sioux City. They owned and operated the Plainview Roller Rink in Plainview in 1971 and ran it for 28 years. He was also janitor and maintenance at Pierce High School for four years. He was maintenance and groundskeeper at Pierce Manor for 27 years. Darold retired in 2002.

Darold enjoyed camping, fishing, playing cards and going to the casinos. Darold and Donna wintered in Texas nine years. He was a member of Christ Lutheran Church in Pierce.
