



Darrell L. "Gunner" Clark

Services for Darrell L. "Gunner" Clark, 76, Norfolk, will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Norfolk. The Rev. Gregory Carl will officiate with burial in Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery. Military rites will be conducted by American Legion Post 16, Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1644 of Norfolk and the U.S. Air Force Honors Guard.

Visitation will be 4-8 p.m. Wednesday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with a 7 p.m. rosary.

He died Saturday, May 25, 2013, at St. Joseph's Nursing Home in Norfolk.

He was born on May 12, 1937, at Stanton, the son of Roy and Elvera (Wilson) Clark. He attended school in Stanton and later received his GED while serving in the military. Darrell was a military veteran, serving in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War from March 17, 1955, until July 29, 1958.

He married Carol Leiting on July 22, 1959, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Norfolk. After Darrell and Carol were married, Darrell was a trucker for Pepsi, Miller Produce, and Sun Flowers. Darrell was self-employed and owned his own truck until retiring in 2003.

He was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church-St. Mary's Parish in Norfolk, the American Legion and the VFW.

Survivors include two daughters, Teresa Cox of South Sioux City and Debra and Jerry Klintobe of Norfolk; three grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren; one sister, Marlene Geu of Stanton.

He was preceded in death by his wife in 2006, his parents, Roy and Elvera, an infant daughter, Monica; a son, Greg; a brother, Vernon; a sister Mary; a stepfather, Albert Smith; a stepsister, Effa Smith; two sons-in-law, Ron Cooper and Collin Cox.
