NORFOLK - Darrell L. Cleveland, 59, of Norfolk died Wednesday, Nov. 20, 2013, at the University of Nebraska Medical Center. Visitation will be 3-8 p.m. Sunday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. He was born Nov. 11, 1954, at rural Orchard to Archie and Oral (Jackson) Cleveland. He graduated from Ewing High School in 1973 and Northeast Community College in TV repair and electronics. He was married to Beverly Cooper on Aug. 30, 1985, in Neligh. After marriage, Darrell and Beverly lived in Norfolk. Darrell worked in maintenance at Bel-Air Heritage nursing home from 1986 until 1993. In 1993, Darrell began Cleveland Floor Maintenance Cleaning until 2002, when he started Cleveland Photography. Darrell enjoyed fishing, carpentry work, camping, gardening, canning and spending time with his family. He was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Norfolk, a deacon and did the sound system for the contemporary services.
