After marriage, the couple lived in Pierce. David served in the Nebraska National Guard for six years and was staff sergeant. He worked for Gerhold Construction from 1968 to 1981 and drove truck for K&C Grain from 1981 to 2014. He retired in 2015.

David enjoyed fishing, hunting, going on road trips and watching sports. He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce and the Pierce American Legion.

Survivors are his spouse, Susan Brodhagen of Pierce; his sister, JoAnne (Kermit) Benshoof of Norfolk; his brothers-in-law, Alan (Linda) Frahm of Ponca and Bryan (Robin) Frahm of Lyons; three nieces and two nephews.

He was preceded in death by his two children, Sheila Sue and Paul David; his parents, Arnold and Irene; his in-laws, Gib and Dolly Frahm; his sister-in-law, Diane Doeden; and a nephew, Lucas Doeden.
