David adored younger children and met many through Clarice's work at school and her daycare. Kids were always excited when "Big D" was coming to play with them. David is survived by four children, whom he loved beyond measure, Veronica DeLaCruz, David DeLaCruz Jr., Dreamer DeLaCruz, and Elijah DeLaCruz. His sons are all spitting images of him in his younger years. More importantly was his great love for his four grandchildren Finn Meyer, Emma Meyer, Ellie DeLaCruz, and Riley DeLaCruz.
