He died Thursday, March 3, 2016, at Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk. The son of Fred and Maxine (Otto) Hoogestraat was born July 28, 1956, in Sioux City. He graduated from West Sioux in Hawarden, Iowa, in 1975. Dave joined the U.S. Navy right after graduation and became a steelworker with the Navy Seabees. He attended Northwest Iowa Technical College after leaving active duty, earning a degree in welding. Later, he attended Sioux Empire College in Hawarden, where he earned an associates degree in arts. On March 15, 1980, he married Laura DeBruin at Hawarden, Iowa. The couple were blessed with two children, Jeremy and Erica. They moved with their family to Pierce in 1991, where he took a job with the city of Pierce as the electrical superintendent for the last 25 years. He enjoyed spending time with his family. He loved to go boating, playing Farmville, playing games and cards, watching Notre Dame and the Kansas City Chiefs and occasionally fishing with his grandkids. He was a member of Christ Lutheran Church in Pierce and served two years as an EMT at Hawarden and

24 years as an EMT at Pierce. He served on the board of the Municipal Energy Agency of Nebraska (MEAN) and was the representative to the board of directors for Pierce for 28 years. He also was on the Nebraska Municipal Power Pool board director for the last four years. Survivors are his spouse, Laura Hoogestraat of Pierce; a son, Jeremy and spouse Julie Hoogestraat of Carter Lake, Iowa; a daughter, Erica and spouse Keith Schwager of Omaha; grandchildren: Ryken, Mallory, Cody, Courtney and Kyle; a great-grandson, Theodore; his sister, Roxann and spouse Curt Winterfeld; brother Cal and spouse Carol Hoogestraat, all of Hawarden, Iowa; a father-in-law, John DeBruin and spouse Betty of Rock Valley, Iowa; and many cherished aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins. He was preceded in death by his parents, Fred and Maxine, and mother-in-law, Doris DeBruin. Organist for the funeral will be Kathy Draeger, with the congregation singing "Here I Am Lord," "Amazing Grace" and "How Great Thou Art."
