NORFOLK – Celebration of life service for Rev. David P. Kipp, 69, of Norfolk will be held at 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, April 3, 2024 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Norfolk. Rev. Lee Weander and Rev. Eric Gradberg will be officiating the service. Interment will be held at the Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery, Norfolk. A luncheon will follow the celebration of life service at the Point at the church. Visitation will be held 4:00-7:00 p.m., Tuesday, also at Our Savior Lutheran Church. No flowers please. Pastor Kipp passed away with his family at his side on Tuesday, March 26, 2024 at his residence in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Pastor David Paul Kipp was born in Minneapolis, Minnesota on October 14, 1954 to the late Reverend Frederick and Gertrude Kipp. David graduated from Concordia College – Milwaukee, WI, Concordia University – Mequon, WI, and completed the pastoral colloquy program at the Concordia Theological Seminary in Ft. Wayne, IN. He had served churches and parochial schools of the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod for over 45 years in the States of Wisconsin, California, Illinois, Texas, Kentucky, and Indiana. He had been a

guest preacher, speaker and workshop leader in eleven States and Canada in the areas of youth and family ministries and evangelism. David married Susan Marie (Wendzel) Kipp on July 7, 1973 in Coloma, Michigan.

David's joy and enthusiasm for Jesus was very contagious. Whether in a classroom or in the pulpit, Pastor Kipp presented creative ways of witnessing the Christian faith and teachings of God's Word through music, humor, drama, puppets and object lessons. By the power of the Holy Spirit, David had a gift in equipping, encouraging and spurring people on in the Christian faith. He reached out to the people on a personal level and related to them with much experience.

Though David had retired since November 2019, he had served churches in the Norfolk area in various capacities. Over the last three years, he served part-time as an adult Bible class teacher at Our Savior Lutheran Church – Norfolk, NE.

Surviving members of the family are his wife Susan Kipp of Norfolk, two sons, John (wife Donna) of Bradenton, FL; grandsons Codey and Casey; and Mike (wife Andrea) of Norfolk, NE; granddaughter Audrey and grandson Owen, his two brothers Ron (wife Jeanne); a niece, Amanda, a nephew, Darren, of Torrance, CA; and brother Wally of Portage, MI. He was preceded in death by his parents Rev. Frederick and Gertrude Kipp.

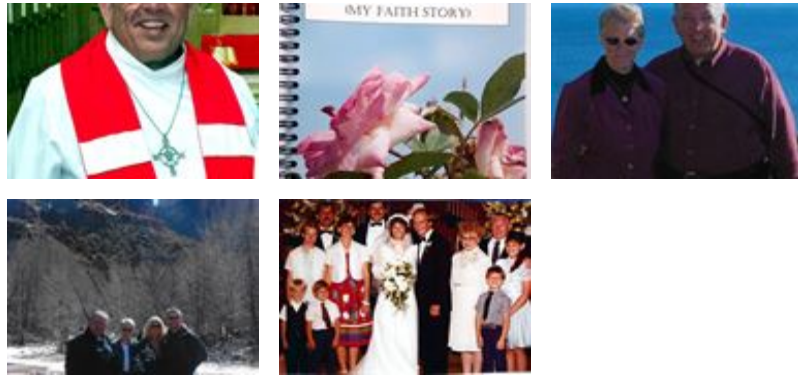
