NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Dawn E. Ditter, 88, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Thursday, November 29, 2018 at the Grace Lutheran Church in Norfolk with Rev. Ray S. Wilke and Rev. Chris Asbury officiating. Interment will be at Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery, Norfolk. Visitation will be 5:00-7:00 p.m., Wednesday at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Dawn died Saturday, November 24, 2018 at the Waterford Assisted Living in Lincoln. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Dawn E. Ditter was born Jan. 18, 1930, in Norfolk, the daughter of Ernest and Lydia (Pentico) Langenberg. She was baptized on June 29, 1930, at the Peace Church in rural Hoskins and confirmed at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Norfolk.

Dawn lived and grew up in Hoskins. She graduated from Norfolk High School in 1946 and then graduated from Wayne State College with a bachelor's degree in teaching.

After graduating from Wayne State, Dawn taught at rural schools in Wayne and Madison counties. She taught at District 87 (Victory School) for 28 years. She retired in 1992 with 34 years of teaching experience.

Dawn was united in marriage to Willard Ditter on Dec. 31, 1968, at Dillon, S.C. The couple made their home in Norfolk all of their married life. Dawn loved to ride horses; one year when she was teaching, she would ride her horse to school. She had a real love for the farm. She rode in many 4th of July parades in Hoskins with her pony.

She was a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Norfolk.

Survivors include a daughter, LaRee Stolp of Hadar; 11 grandchildren; 21 great-grandchildren; a sister-in-law, Marseline Langenberg of Lincoln; and her stepchildren, Dallas (Kathy) Ditter of Ellis, Kan., Sherrie (Don) Maliha of Leigh and Kent (Jessie) Ditter of Torrington, Wyo.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her spouse, Willard in 2017; a daughter, Denise Kanter in 2009; her sons-in-law, Kenny Stolp and Rodney Kanter; and a brother, Dale Langenberg.
