Services for Delbert C. Nathan, 87, of Pierce will be Wednesday at 10:30 a.m. at St. John Lutheran Church here with burial in Prospect View Cemetery and military rites by American Legion Post 72 and the U.S. Army Honor Guard. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday at Stonacek Memorial Chapel. The Rev. Keith Christiansen will officiate. Mr. Nathan died Friday, June 24, 2011, at Pierce. He was born Aug. 27, 1923, at rural Lindsay to Carl and Rosetta (Gross) Nathan and was baptized in 1923 and confirmed in 1937 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Lindsay. He attended St. Paul's Lutheran parochial school, rural Lindsay. He married Elsie Koehlmoos Oct. 4, 1953, at Pilger. He farmed with his father a few years. He was then drafted into the Army in 1946 to 1947. He served in Korea. During that time his family moved to Pierce County. After the military he farmed with his father. After marriage, they farmed northeast of Pierce. Delbert farmed in Pierce County for over 45 years. They resided on the same farm until 1997 when they moved to Pierce. He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, Pierce. Survivors include wife Elsie Nathan of Pierce; two sons, Terry "Tex" and wife Kerry Nathan of Pierce, Randy Nathan of Farmington, N.M.; four grandchildren, Cory Mattson, Heather Mattson, Adam and Greg Nathan; five great-grandchildren, Devin, Payton and Aiden Gnat, Keaton and Carissa Mattson. He was preceded in death by parents and daughter Cindy Nathan, who passed away Sept. 29, 1976.
