



## Delbert M. Wulf

PIERCE -- Memorial services for Delbert M. Wulf, 71, of Grand Island formerly of Pierce will be held at 1:15 p.m., Thursday, December 29, 2016 at the Grand Island Veterans Home in the Chapel. Private family burial will be held at the Prospect View Cemetery in Pierce. Delbert passed away Monday, December 26, 2016, at the Grand Island Veterans Home. Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce is in charge of the arrangements.

Delbert was the son of the late Walter and Wilma (Wragge) Wulf. He was born on December 9, 1945, baptized and confirmed at Christ Lutheran Church. He grew up on the family farm west of Pierce, attended District 26, and graduated from Pierce High School in 1965. He served in Vietnam for one year. After his honorable discharge from the Army, he continued his life-long love of owning and training quarter horses and breeding and racing thoroughbreds.

For several years, he trained horses for owner-trainer Don Von Hemmel and worked several years on racetracks in Florida. Before suffering a paralyzing stroke in April of 2010, he had worked 15 years for Great Dane in Wayne. He is survived by his sister Janet Wulf of Lincoln, brother Harold Wulf of Randolph, niece Chris (Justin) Bahr and children Jacob and Kaylee of Osmond, nephew Craig (Melissa) Wulf and son Evan of Lincoln, and aunt Lavern Schulz of Pierce.
