



Delilah Beltz

June 6, 1923 - August 22, 2014

PIERCE — Services for Delilah Beltz, 91, of Pierce will be at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at the Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. Burial will be in the Prospect View Cemetery at Pierce with the Rev. Gordon Bruce and Vicar Eric Oberman officiating. Visitation will be 4-7 p.m. Monday at the Stonacek Memorial Chapel at Pierce. She died Friday, Aug. 22, 2014, at Heritage of Bel Air in Norfolk. She was born June 6, 1923, on a farm near Fordyce to Henry and Margaretha (Mumm) Wiese. She was baptized Aug. 19, 1923, and confirmed Nov. 19, 1936, at Evangelical Lutheran Church, rural Bloomfield. She attended country schools in Knox County through the eighth grade and Center High School. She married Donald Newton of Bloomfield on June 20, 1943, and on Aug. 26, 1951, married Gerald E. Beltz in Norfolk at the home of Rev. Scheips. After marriage, they moved to Brunswick, where they farmed and sold farm products until 1952. Her husband then became postmaster at Brunswick and later became a rural mail carrier from 1963 to 1976. They raised their seven children there in Brunswick. In 1980 the couple moved to Pierce, and after the death of her husband, she continued to live in her home in Pierce until 2011. She then went to reside with her son Dennis and family in Norfolk. Delilah became a resident of the Madison House in Norfolk from October through December 2013 and moved to Heritage of Bel Air in Norfolk in January 2014. She was a member of Zion Lutheran Church, Pierce, Zion Ladies Aid and volunteered doing devotions at the Pierce Manor. Survivors are seven children, Shirley and husband Walter Petersen Jr. of Norfolk,

Richard Beltz of Norfolk, Susan and husband Ron Green of Norfolk, Jerry and wife Zandy Beltz of Norfolk, Dennis and wife Colleen Beltz of Norfolk, Michael and wife Vel of Grand Island, Curt and wife Joann of Oxnard, Calif.; 15 grandchildren, 19 great-grandchildren, nine great-great-grandchildren; one sister, Adeline Backer of Laramie, Wyo.; three sisters-in-law, Esther Wiese of Benkelman, Edna Beltz of Pierce and Betty Beltz of Plainview; nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents, Henry and Margaretha; three brothers, Raymond, Alvin and Lyle; her husband Gerald passed away July 1998; two sisters, Beatrice and Marie. Organist will be Dottie Ahlers and soloist Margret Jenkins with "In the Garden," "How Great Thou Art" and congregational hymn "Just As I Am."
