



## Delilah H. "Dee" Planer

January 27, 1920 - April 10, 2018

NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Delilah H. "Dee" Planer 98, of Norfolk will be held at 2:00 p.m., Monday, April 16, 2018 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with Rev. Paul Hirsch officiating. Interment will be at the Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery, Norfolk. Visitation will be held 4:00-6:00 p.m., Sunday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Dee passed away Tuesday, April 10, 2018 at her residence in Norfolk.

Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Delilah H. "Dee" Planer was born Jan. 27, 1920, in Pierce, the daughter of Charles and Ida (Nitz) Voecks. She attended school at District 36 in Pierce County, graduated from Pierce High School, later attended Norfolk Junior College and Northeast Tech, was a graduate of Eastern Conservatory of Music in string instruments. After graduating from college, Dee taught and played the steel guitar professionally.

She married La Vern Planer on June 7, 1939, at Zion East Lutheran Church in rural Hoskins. Dee and La Vern farmed in Pierce County for 23 years. They semi-retired in 1962 and moved to Norfolk. She began employment at the Nebraska Veterans Home as the recreational coordinator, then later attended Northeast Tech and continued as occupational therapy director, re-motivational instructor and library manager until retiring in 1985.

She played in several musical bands until organizing their own band called "The Accidentals." Music was Dee's life; her first radio program was at the age of 10. She, along with her spouse and son, played music professionally for 52

years serving in three states.

She was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Norfolk, the American Legion Auxiliary in Norfolk and the VFW Auxiliary of Norfolk

Survivors include a grandson, Eugene Planer and his girlfriend, Jennifer Hale, of Norfolk; numerous nieces and nephews; and a sister-in-law, Barb (Joe) Hegr of Norfolk.

She was preceded in death by her spouse, La Vern Planer; a son, Val Ray Planer; and parents Charles and Ida Voecks.

Organist will be Diane Herbolsheimer.

Casket bearers will be Brian Planer, Bradley Planer, John Planer, Fred Planer, Darral Voecks and Tom Clausen.
