

## Delmer D. Gansebom

May 25, 1930 - October 7, 2017

OSMOND — Funeral service for Delmer D. Gansebom, 87, Osmond, will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday, Oct. 12, 2017 at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond. Burial will be in the parish cemetery, rural Osmond. Visitation will be 4-7:00 p.m. Wednesday also at the church. Stonacek Memorial Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

He died Saturday, Oct. 7, 2017, at St. Joseph's Care Center in Norfolk.

Delmer D. Gansebom, son of August and Emma (Dralle) Gansebom, was born May 25, 1930, in rural Osmond. He was baptized on June 22, 1930, and confirmed April 18, 1943, both at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond by the Rev. Eric Holstein. He attended School District 34 through sixth grade, Immanuel Lutheran parochial school for seventh and eighth grade and graduated from Osmond High School in 1947. He then attended Wayne State College and then taught school at Foster Public Schools.

Delmer served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War from March 27, 1952, to March 26, 1954. He was stationed at Fort Lee, Va., with Quarter Master Schools.

He married Joan Brummond on Feb. 10, 1957, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond by the Rev. Marcus Gerike. After married, they farmed south of Osmond for 40 years on the family farm. They hosted three foreign exchange students. From 1994 to 2010, he worked at the Pierce County Veteran's Service Office.

He loved his family and grandchildren, gardening, birds, flowers, playing

cards, and visiting with friends. He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church and served as chairman of the congregation, vice chairman, secretary, Sunday school superintendent, superintendent assistant, treasurer and elder. He also served on the Osmond Rural Fire Board, was a lifetime member of American Legion since 1955, member of 40 & 8 since 1994. He served on the ASCS committee nine years, the fair board for six years, was a 4-H leader, a member of Gideon's International and was a hospice volunteer.

Survivors are his children, Lisa (Greg) Kralicek of Osmond, Tim (Earleen) Gansebom of Norfolk, Lori (Todd) Neuhalfen of Norfolk, Tom (Mary) Gansebom of Norfolk; 11 grandchildren; his sisters-in-law, Joyce Gansebom of Norfolk and Sue Gansebom of Carroll; his brothers-in-law, Don (Marilyn) Brummond of Centennial, Colo., and James (Judy) Brummond of Walton. He was preceded in death by his parents, August and Emma; spouse Joan Gansebom; brothers Norman in infancy, Dwaine, Lloyd and Kenneth; his sisters, LaVern Kenny and Elnor Bingham; one grandson, Joshua Gansebom; and his brothers-in-law, Keith Kenny and Don Bingham.

Organist will be Lori Koehler and soloist will be Ethan Gansebom on "Lord's Prayer." The recorded hymn will be "Steal Away" by Norman Luboff performed by Norfolk High School Choir. Congregational hymns will be "Rock Of Ages," "I Know That My Redeemer Lives," "Just As I Am" and "Holy, Holy, Holy."

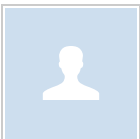
