OSMOND -- Funeral service for Delores A.D. Kumm, 86, of Osmond will be held at 10:30 a.m., Monday, May 21, 2018 at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond with Rev. Glen Emery officiating. Interment will be at the Immanuel Lutheran Cemetery, rural Osmond. Visitation will be 4:00 - 8:00 p.m., Sunday, also at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond.

Delores died Wednesday, May 16, 2018 at the Plainview Manor.

Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Osmond is in charge of the arrangements.

Delores was born on Jan. 9, 1932 to Frank and Adele (Pfanstiel) Stark at Stark Valley. She was baptized on Feb. 7, 1932, at St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church at Stark Valley by the Rev. E. Budde and confirmed at Stark Valley St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church by the Rev. E. Budde. She attended District 23 at Plainview through eighth grade and graduated from Plainview High School in 1949.

Delores married Duane Kumm on Sept. 17, 1950, at St Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church at Stark Valley. After marriage, Delores worked side by side with her spouse on their farm west of McLean. They moved to McLean in 1980. Duane and Delores were parents to a daughter and three sons. Her spouse, Duane, passed away in February 2000.

In 2009, Delores was inducted into the Pierce County Hall of Fame in recognition of her work and support of the Pierce County Fair. She was active at Immanuel Lutheran Church, serving as Sunday School teacher, as a member of the ladies aid and various other committees. She was a lifetime

member of the McLean Extension Club. She was instrumental for organizing the Wednesday morning McLean Coffee Club. Delores enjoyed playing cards, going to the casino and eating fish on Friday nights.

Survivors include her children: daughter Linda (Ralph) Mickley of Hannibal, Mo.; three sons, Don (Cathy) Kumm of Wausa, Harvey Kumm of Osmond and Scott (Teresa) Kumm of McLean; seven grandchildren; two stepgrandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her spouse, Duane; her parents, Frank and Adele; a granddaughter, Andrea Marie Kumm; two half-sisters, Edna and Mildred; a half-brother, Harold; two sisters, Martha Luehrs and Lucille Goetz; and a brother, Henry Stark.

Organist for the funeral will be Lori Koehler with congregational hymns "What a Friend We Have in Jesus," "I'm But a Stranger Here," "I Know That My Redeemer Lives" and "Lift High the Cross."
