Dennis was born on February 14, 1946 in Pierce to William H. Sr. and Edna (Koehler) Buss. He attended grade school at Pierce and graduated from Pierce High School in 1964. Dennis was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce, where he was baptized on March 3, 1946 as well as confirmed on April 10, 1960. After graduating from high school Dennis farmed for one year before being drafted. He served his country in the United States Army from November 17, 1965 to May 11, 1966. After returning home from the military Dennis farmed in the Pierce County area. Dennis retired from farming in 2009 and moved to Randolph.
