NORFOLK -- Dennis J. Gaspers, 79, died Tuesday, Nov. 19, 2013, at Faith Regional Health Services. Memorial services will be at 11 a.m. Saturday at St. Mary's Catholic Church with private family inurnment services at a later date and the Rev. Dan Andrews officiating. Military rites will be by American Legion Post 16 and VFW Post 1644 of Norfolk and the United States Army Honors Guard. Visitation will be 5-7 p.m. Friday at the church with a 7 p.m. rosary. They farmed northwest of Lindsay. They moved to Norfolk in 1998. Dennis worked at Wal-Mart for 11 years in the produce department. He retired from there in 2009. Dennis enjoyed singing in the adult and folk choirs at church, gardening and raising flowers. He was a member of St. Mary's and Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Norfolk, and belonged to the parish choir and folk choir and Knights of Columbus. While at Lindsay, they belonged to Lindsay Holy Family Church. He sang in the church choir and was a trustee. He served on the Walker Township Board, Newman Grove School Board and Farmer's Co-op Board of Directors. Survivors include wife Phyllis Gaspers of Norfolk; children Allen Gaspers of Omaha, John and wife Alice Gaspers of Columbus, Dan Gaspers of Lincoln and Jeff and wife Sandy Gaspers of Norfolk; five
